PRIVACY NOTICE

1. Who we are?

Designed2Move Limited (Designed2Move) are a small team of UK based specialist physiotherapists who provide bespoke functional rehabilitation programmes for active people who have suffered severe or multiple injury.

This privacy notice explains how we use any personal information we collect about you when you use our services and this website.

Designed2Move is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using our services and this website, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy notice.

2. What information do we collect about you?

We collect, process and retain personal information about you only when you:

- submit your information to us using the "Contact Us" form
- directly contact us (email, website or telephone)
- opt-in to our newsletter

This information can include:

- name
- phone number
- email address
- client location
- visiting IP address

Unless a person voluntarily submits personal data to us (for example, by sending us an email or completing the contact form), we cannot personally identify an individual).

We use the information only for the purpose you provided to us.

It may include:

- responding to your request
- sending out e-Newsletters
- providing you rehabilitation

3. How will we use the information about you?

We collect information about you to process your enquiry or manage the service we provide for you.

We will process (collect, store and use) the information you provide in a manner compatible with the EU's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). We will endeavour to keep your information accurate and up to date, and not keep it longer than is necessary.

This is what we do for the following:

- **Prospects:** We use your personal information to respond to any general enquiries you may have made to us via our contact us form, email, telephone or any other method of communication. We will use this information to follow-up your enquiry.
- **Clients & Mentees:** We use your personal information so that we can deliver the service(s) you have contracted us to deliver for you. This may include providing rehabilitation or coaching services.
- **Contractors & Associates:** We use your personal information to process your payments for services provided, and to manage your service performance.
- **Job Applicants:** We use your personal information to assess your suitability for the role you have applied for and potentially shortlist you for the job role. All the information you provide us will only be used for progressing your job application, or to fulfil legal or regulatory requirements if necessary.
- **Website Visitors:** We use your information collected from the website to personalise your repeat visits to our website. Designed2Move will not share your information for marketing purposes with any other company.

4. Our legal grounds for processing your information

We may rely on one or more of the following legal grounds to process your personal information:

- **Contract:** Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR, which relates to the processing necessary to perform a contract or to take steps at your request, before entering a contract. We will use if you become a client, mentee, contractor or associate.
- **Consent:** Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR, which relies on your freely-given consent at the time you provide your personal information to us. We will always make it clear what your information will be used for and provide a link to our privacy policy and the ability to opt out of communications. We will use this when you sign-up to our e-Newsletters.
- **Legitimate Interests:** Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, which relates to our legitimate interests communicating with our clients, prospects and mentees to introduce them to services, or market similar services that would be of interest and benefit to them.

5. Where we store your information?

We store personal data in digital format on secure cloud servers and systems hosted in the European Union (EU) and the United States (US). Where data is stored on servers located in the US we rely on the Privacy Shield Framework to transfer this information. Access to personal data is highly restricted internally for approved business purposes only.

Any personal data collected in paper form (e.g. contracts, feedback forms, business cards, etc.) are securely filed at our office location in the UK.

6. How long do we keep your information?

We have data retention policies and procedures designed to help ensure that we comply with our legal obligations in relation to the retention and deletion of your personal information. Personal information that we process for any purpose or purposes will not be kept for longer than is necessary.

We may, however, retain personal information for an additional period as is permitted or required under applicable laws, for legal, tax, or regulatory reasons, or for legitimate and lawful business purposes.

7. Keeping personal data secure and disclosing your information

Transmitting information over the internet is generally not completely secure. We have procedures and security in place to keep personal data secure once it is in our systems.

We will not share personal information with any 3rd party organisation for market research, marketing, or commercial purposes without specific consent from the user.

We use data processors who are third parties who provide elements of services for us. We have contracts in place with our data processors. This means that they cannot do anything with your personal information unless we have instructed them to do it. They will not share your personal information with any organisation apart from us. They will hold it securely and retain it for the period we instruct.

However, we may share information (including personal information) if we have a legal obligation to do so, or if we have to enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements. This may include submitting information for legal reasons.

7.1. e-Newsletters and Mailing Lists

As part of the registration process for our e-newsletter, we collect personal information. We use that information to send you e-Newsletters about our company. We don't rent or sell email lists with other organisations and businesses.

We use a third-party provider, MailChimp, to deliver our newsletter. We gather statistics around email opening and clicks using industry standard technologies to help us monitor and improve our e-newsletter. You can unsubscribe to general mailings at any time of the day or night by clicking the unsubscribe link at the bottom of any of our emails.

7.2. CRM

As part of our process for you to request a callback from us we use a third-party CRM (customer relationship management) provider, Hubspot to hold the information you share with us, so we can call you back. For more information, please see [Hubspot's privacy notice](#). You have the right for us to erase your contact details from our system by emailing our [Data Compliance Manager](#).

We provide you the option from our [request a call back form](#) to sign-up to our e-Newsletters. You will need to give us your consent freely to receive our e-Newsletters.

8. Access to your information and correction

You have the right at any time to:

- Ask for a copy of the information about you held by us in our records
- Ask us to correct any inaccuracies in your information
- Make a request to us to delete what personal data of yours we hold
- Object to receiving any marketing communications from us.
